

Day Care for Older People - Auckland (Nov 2016)

This listing is for caregivers requiring day care for a dependent older person. The information is arranged in broad geographical areas: Central, West, North and South Auckland to help guide your search. All prices include GST.

Many rest homes and long-term care hospitals will accept a day stay client on an informal basis. The cost of day care ranges from \$5 to \$90 per day, with a cluster around \$50 per day. There may be extra cost for those offering transport.

A separate listing for more independent older people called *Activities for Older People* is also available from Seniorline.

Subsidies

Carer Support Subsidy can be used to help with fees where the day stay is used to provide a rest for a caregiver. Eligibility for this subsidy is assessed by the Needs Assessment and Service Coordination service (NASC) contracted to your local District Health Board. Disability Allowance up to \$61.69 a week may apply. It is income tested.

Free day care may be available for people with a diagnosis of dementia or Alzheimer's. Day programmes contracted for this type of service are limited. Needs Assessment and Service Co-ordination assess and authorise the subsidy.
